

Will God take away sins that plague us?

My experience is no.

He will grant the power to overcome and has broken the power of sin to rule over us

Rom 6:1-14 excerpts

... We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?... For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin— because anyone who has died has been set free from sin... In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires.... For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law, but under grace.

We may need prayer to break any demonic powers behind sins in our life and to break the power of habits.

So I pray like this to deal with anger and frustrations and not let them rule in me:

Abba Father please grant me this day a check in my spirit when these emotions grow in me so I can submit my thoughts and emotions to obedience to Jesus by your Spirit's help and strengthening and so not let these things control me.

I ask these in the confidence of faith because this is in His will that my behavior is no longer controlled by these things but by His Spirit.

That this is according to His will:

Rom 6:13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Rom 7:6 But now we have been delivered from the law, having died to what we were held by, so that we should serve in the newness of the Spirit and not in the oldness of the letter.

Gal 5:18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

That we can have confidence if asking according to His will:

1Jn 5:14-15 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him

That when we have such confidence we should apply faith and believe our request will be answered:

Jas 1:5-6 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Jas 1:6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind.

I believe the same principle described here regarding asking for wisdom applies in that when we know it is something according to God's will and His desires we should not doubt but rather give thanks for God supplying our need in this.

Mat 7:11 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!

Then after giving thanks receive peace about the matter

Php 4:6-7 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
